



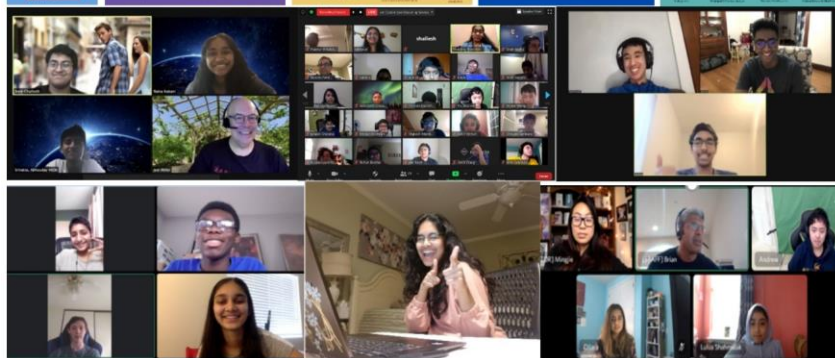

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY ONLINE HACKATHON

In October 2020, Shooting Stars Foundation partnered with **AMGEN** to conduct **The Equal Opportunity Hackathon**. The event attracted **250 registrations worldwide** with **25% from underserved communities**. **Una Krisnan**, SSF volunteer, led **47 Amgen employees** to participate in the hackathon as organizers, mentors, speakers and judges. During the 12-hour hackathon, 27 technology projects were created to solve some problems that are currently affecting the lives of many people in the world – access to healthcare, mental health, diversity, inclusion and belonging, ways to celebrate festivals, birthdays and anniversaries during COVID. Participants gushed about their experience. They learned to collaborate with peers from diverse backgrounds and varying levels of coding knowledge, understanding and leveraging each other's strengths. They also learned new programming languages and applied and enhanced their coding skills by creating an app or a website to solve a problem affecting many people. They made lasting relationships – friends and mentors, through the hackathon; and many teams plan on continuing to work on their hackathon projects. Mentors and judges found it rewarding for this skill-based online volunteering opportunity to impact young lives and to give back to the community. They want more ! Thank you, **Una**, for facilitating this event. **Amgen generously donated \$10,000** for this event, **sponsoring 10 scholars for their college education**.

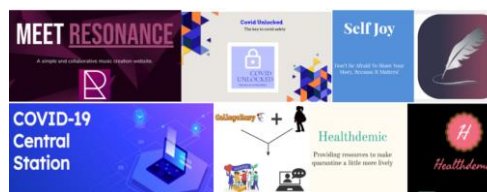

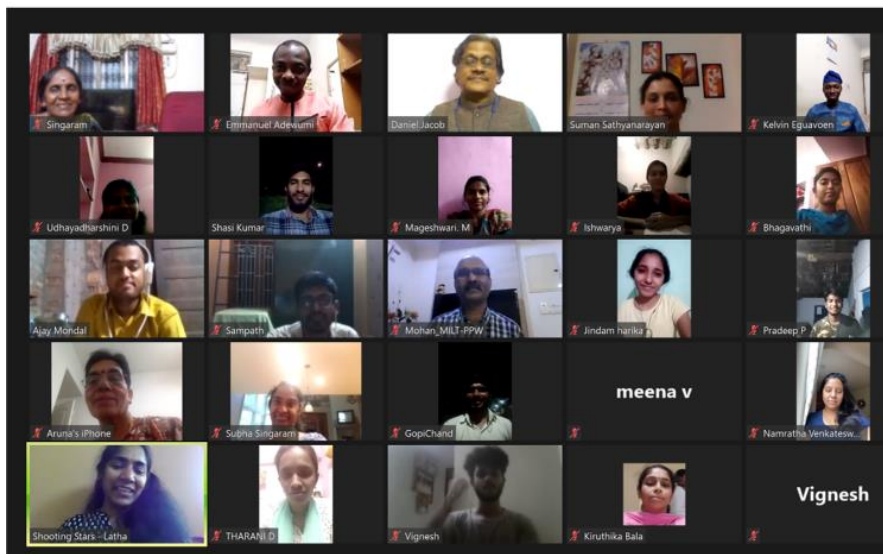

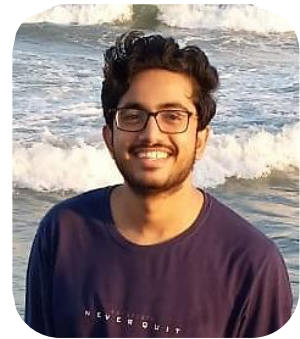
3. If you weren't leading SSF, what would you be doing?
