



#### **STEM Programs**

#### EAH Game Design Camp (April 11th - 15th)

We are happy to report that SSF completed the first ever Game Design Camp this April. This camp was put together through our partnership with EAH Low Income Housing, containing 14 students between 2nd and 6th grade from 5 different EAH Locations in California. At SSF, we are dedicated to increasing access to STEM education for all, with the goal of our Game Design Camp to introduce students to game design and programming basics in a fun and hands-on way. Students worked with their mentors to create a video game from start to finish. Students showcased their video games to SSF and EAH reps, played each others video games, and competed for first place. With this great turnout, we are excited at the opportunity to continue hosting Game Design Camps with different groups of students!





#### **Netscout Cyberathon**

On May 21-22, SSF hosted the Cyber Security Hackathon Sponsored by NETSCOUT, a provider of application network performance and management products. Α Cyber Security Hackathon or "Cyberathon" is a 24 hour event where participants use data science resources to create solutions to different problems in an intensive, collaborative environment. Participants were challenged complete projects based on their experience level. The Beginner Level Challenge included a set of Cyber War Games that needed to be solved as a team. The Intermediate / Advanced team were challenged to build a bulletproof User Authentication system with innovative features. Teams were judged on the following categories: ldeation, Innovation, Technical Functionality and Design, and the "WOW" Factor of the approach.

In preparation for the event, SSF hosted a series of events including a Cyber Security Concepts Webinar where participants discussed how Cybersecurity will play a key role in our future towards the right to privacy, a cybersecurity panel where participants had the opportunity to hear first hand experiences from industry leaders, and Cybersecuirty expert keynote speakers that provided provided insight on Cybersecurity and their experience in the field.
