This quarter, our January 21st AAUW funded All Girls Hackathon in San Jose and online impacted the lives of hundreds of high schoolers. The journey leading up to the hackathon was filled with learning, collaboration, and inspiration, and we're grateful to have shared it with such dedicated individuals.



The exclusive Wix how to session for further Huerta Dolores students exemplified our commitment to providing tailored opportunities for growth and learning. The highlight of the prehackathon events was undoubtedly the Women Tech Panel. in where distinguished industry leaders shared their personal journeys and invaluable With over insights. 320 registered participants forming 60 teams across both online and in-person modes, the energy and enthusiasm were palpable. The submission of 48 impactful "Tech for Good" projects is a testament to the creativity and dedication participants.

Moreover, the long-term impact of the All Girls Hack 2024 is evident in the feedback received. With a significant percentage of participants reporting increased expertise in coding/programming and expressing a heightened interest in pursuing STEM majors in college, we have succeeded in igniting a passion for technology and innovation.

AMD PERVASIVE AI DEVELOPER CONTEST

The AMD Pervasive Al Developer Contest, in which Shooting Stars Foundation participated as an outreach partner, made a significant impact by encouraging students to register for the challenge, particularly focusing on hardware-related projects. Through strategic outreach efforts, SSF successfully facilitated 2,600 registrations for the contest, accounting for a significant portion of the overall international submissions.



The outreach and implementation process included engaging 100+ college leaders through a Zoom session, conducting workshops and sessions in 17 colleges, and providing coaching and support to students through SSF coaches trained on AMD projects.



This comprehensive approach resulted in over 500 idea submissions, showcasing the creativity and innovation of the participants. The ideation projects ranged from MedAI: Instant Medical Insights Platform to AI-Assisted Autonomous Helper Robot with Multimodal Interaction, demonstrating the diverse applications of AI in various fields.


