IBM Z DATATHON - IBM'S FLAGSHIP ANNUAL TECH EVENT

October 19-20, the IBM Z On Datathon 2024 brought together participants 5.200 +from 37 countries for an intense 24-hour challenge, leveraging the IBM platform LinuxONE to develop solutions for real-world problems.

The event featured both virtual participation and in-person hacking at five prestigious institutions-Engineering Saveetha College (India) Global Academy of Technology (India), Imperial College London (UK), Tshwane University of Technology (South Africa), and Hochschule Mainz (Germany). IBM SMEs were present on-site to guide and mentor students throughout the competition.

With the theme Tech For Good, participants explored cutting-edge technologies in AI, security, and data science, focusing on solutions that drive positive impact.

The event saw an overwhelming 9,104 registrations, leading to 320 final project submissions from 2,790 participants.

Beyond cash prizes, winners received an exclusive opportunity to attend and speak at IBM Tech Exchange 2024, further amplifying their innovations on a global stage.
